Talion Gallery is pleased to present the solo show "I in the Novel" by Takuma Ishikawa.

This exhibition will be the first solo show at Talion Gallery in three years, after Ishikawa's residence in United States for one year.

Takuma Ishikawa critically questions photography and video as media, discovering the possibility of camera to create an unique formative medium which fiction and non-fiction infiltrate into each other. The artist has been presented his photography and video works as filling the gaps between the systemized genre of arts as painting, photography and cinema.

Recently, Ishikawa' s practice is known as a series of video works which was created by editing a large number of pictures taken by the high-speed continuous shooting of the single-lens reflex camera.

In this solo exhibition, the artist will showcase a new video installation "I in the Novel" as the sequel to his past photographic work "A Novelist' s Idea" created in 2005.

Unreleased work "A Novelist's Idea" is consisted of a sequential narrative photographs which suggest a novelist's coverage in Tokyo Wangan area. The work is consisted of the relationship between the documentary of the landscape and the idea of novel, as an invisible fiction.

As for the new work "I in the Novel", Japanese novelist Natsuki Koyata, who won the Mishima Yukio Award in 2018, will be featured in the work as the role of novelist, following the previous work "A Novelist's Idea".
