

Sabbatical Company is the art collective formed in 2015 with 4 artists, Ai Sugiura, Shoko Masunaga, Akiko Minowa and Yasuko Watanabe. They have been achieving various projects to bond their unnoticed curiosities through their dialogues, acquiring different terms from their each time while they have been working with their different methods.

"OR" in this exhibition title has been existing since the first Sabbatical Company was formed, to show one of their possibilities. Within the exhibition "OR Have a good day." which took place in Gunma, 2016, "OR" was proposed as another possibility opposite to spend time at same place, putting their feeling "If we cannot stay togehter, please have a good day". Since then three of the members have experienced residences at domestic places and overseas, and literality continued their activities from distant places until 2019.

Now they are living closely after a long separation but Sabbatical Company is questioning again about "to spend time together and its distance" in the same way that many peoples practice under this global pandemic. As they have talked each other "let's state our activities after 10 years" at the start of the group, they are starting to search their words for coming 2025. Their sway and perplexity revolve to the keyword "OR" again. This exhibition "OR We are still chatting." invite the musucian Toshihiro Yanai as their collaborator, to form thier communications with power of music, which stand before the words are named as the words .

Sabbatical Company The Present Place

Sabbatical Company was formed in 2015 and at the start of the group under the slogan of "Share time before becoming words", we have decided that "At now, let's do not name what we are going to do. And let's look back our activities after 10 years and sum the words born of our projects". Untill now we have worked on 9 projects and try to consider while picking up the words one by one which generated from them. 6 years have passed from our start. It is a little less than 4 years by given time 10th anniversary. During this period, we are trying to continue our practices while prolonging and dodging to be put in context or to be assesed. Currently, Sabbatical Company starts thinking the way of our activities toward 2025. In this exhibition we start up a new project to show our present place under this circumstances, inviting Toshihiro Yanai again who were the collaborator of the project in 2017 to deliver our time of searching words with help of music.

"OR", this word has been continiously existing since we starts as a keyword to suggest a certain kind of possibility of Sabbatical Company's activities. At the project "OR Have a good day." in 2016, the word was presented as another possibility opposite to spend time at same place, putting their feeling "We cannot stay togehter but please have a good day". As we expected, since this year three of the members have experienced residences at domestic places and overseas, and literality continued their activities from distant places until 2019. And after 2020, global pandemic has spread while they live closely after a long separation. Sabbatical Company is questioning again about to spend time together and its distance in the same way that many peoples practice. To use slowly and effectively our own given 4 years, we have made our sway and perplexity revolve to the keyword "OR" again.

The most part of Sammatical Company's meating is always a trivial convesation. New discovery is often happened to be made at the very next moment after chatting and laughing about exiting things recently found, delicious foods and various rumors, forgetting today's agenda. For us, every chat is a milestone connecting to important discovery. Picking up the overlooked and forgotten words carefully, and take time to see them once again. We think that prolonged time enamles to doing it. We are still chatting "OR OR OR OR......" to postpone the conclusion.
